

#### **Membership Qualifications and Procedures**

- All prospective members must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age.
- All petitions received prior to the scheduled monthly meeting will be presented at this meeting and voted upon at that meeting.
- A two-thirds (2/3) vote of members present shall elect prospective members to membership.
- Annual Club dues are \$30 per person per year. Club dues shall be due and payable at the Re-Up party in January each year
- Applicants who join August 1st or later in the year will pay \$20 in dues.
