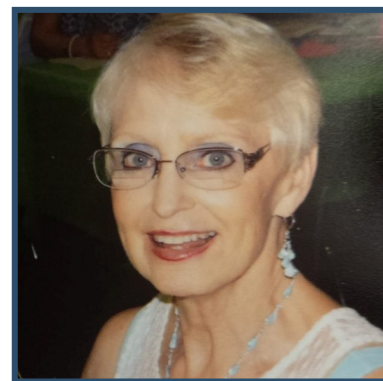

FASA Bylaws approved on September 12, 2023 BYLAWS of THE FAYETTEVILLE AREA SHAG ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE 4. MEMBERS SECTION 1. All prospective members must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age. Applications received prior to the scheduled monthly meeting will be presented at this meeting and voted upon at that meeting. A two-thirds (2/3) vote of members present shall elect prospective members to membership. SECTION 2. Club dues shall be \$30 per person per year, due and payable no later than January 31 each year. Applicants who join August 1st or later in the year will pay \$20 in dues.

To rejoin FASA, bring cash or check to a General Membership Meeting or Monthly Party in the amount of \$30 to rejoin.
