

FASA Business Meeting 8:00 p.m. November 8, 2016 The meeting was called to order by president, Andy Privette, at 8:00 p.m. Minutes from the October meeting were read. Dwayne Baggett made a motion to accept the minutes as read, seconded by Johnny Boyles. A vote was taken and minutes were accepted as read. The treasurer's report was distributed. Andy Privette mentioned that in order to maintain an active status for the money market account, deposits and/ or withdrawals need to be made regularly so that a fee will not be charged. Penny Council, treasurer, said that there has been no activity with the money market account in at least four years and we need to consider making deposits/withdrawals.
