Your FASA Board of Directors has wisely made the decision to **CANCEL** the November and December Membership Meetings and Parties due to uncertainty surrounding the ongoing restrictions related to the Corona Virus.

Currently, North Carolina is under Phase 3 for Corona Virus restrictions until November 15th at the earliest. The rules for each Phase can seem complicated. Under Phase 3, bars, like the Elks Lodge, our meeting and party home, must limit the number of guests with tables required to be 6 feet apart. Our party room is not that large, so in order to meet space requirements not many of us would be allowed to attend a party at any one time. Shag Icon Award

Did you know that SIX FASA members have received the Shag Icon Award? That's quite a high number for one shag club and certainly something of which to be proud. The first member of our club to receive this award is Dwayne Baggett (2001), a FASA Past President, FASA Perpetual Board Past Chairman and member of both the SOS Board and SOS Enhancement Committee. Our second Icon is David Sessoms (2005), a two-time FASA President, member of the FASA Perpetual Board as well as a member of the Association of Beach and Shag Club DJs. One of FASA's founders, the late Eddie Monsour (2005), was a two-time FASA Past President, Chairman of the FASA Perpetual Board and Chairman of the Hall of Fame Foundation. Past President and Carolina Shag Instructor Chris Jestes (2009) was also a member of the SOS Enhancement Committee. Kathi Baloyot (2015) is a FASA Past President and Co-Chairman of the FASA Perpetual Board. Don Bunn (2015), a FASA Past President, Carolina Shag Instructor and competitive shagger, was nominated by the Raleigh Shag Club but we're claiming him as he's a past president.

All of these individuals worked tirelessly and gave graciously of their time and talents to FASA as well as to the shag world in general. Their accomplishments are too numerous to mention in this small space.

If you know of someone who you feel is worthy, you must complete a nomination form which must be signed by the current FASA President. Here is information from shagdance.com:

"The purpose of the Icon Award is to recognize individuals who have made outstanding contributions within their own (Full Member, A.C.S.C.) shag club. Nominees for this award have made significant efforts and contributions to their shag club & are clearly outstanding members of the shag community. Although some of these nominees may go on to be well known in the shag world (the A.C.S.C. or S.O.S., the C.S.A., the DJ Association, etc.) many of these individuals may not be known outside of their own club. This award has come to be one of the most highly prized awards that a shagger can attain.

To nominate a shagger for this award the president of an A.C.S.C. club must submit the completed Shagging Icon Award Nomination form by November 1st. of the current year. The Nomination must be approved by the Club's Board and signed by the Club's current President.

The Icon Award Nominations are evaluated and scored based on predetermined criteria by a 9 member evaluation team. The evaluation team consists of volunteers from past Icon award recipients who are selected by random drawing at the ACSC Summer Workshop. The team's evaluation scores are submitted to the Icon Committee Co-Chairs who tally the end results. Names of the new Icons are announced in January at the Mid-Winer Workshop. The forms must be mailed to Novelene Powell."


